#### Instant Meeting Web Moderator

Instant Meeting Web Moderator is an easy-to-use web-based tool that allows you to manage an Instant Meeting Service conference over the web. A Web Moderator provides you with a variety of features, including:

- The ability to modify your Instant Meeting Service features (e.g., lock/unlock your conference, activate/ deactivate call continuation, conduct ad-hoc roll calls, and choose call entry options)
- The flexibility to isolate a participant and mute/un-mute his or her line
- The opportunity to remotely disconnect one or several participants
- The option to dial out to additional participants
- The ability to screen incoming participants in a "waiting room" prior to opening the main conference room (Leaders can then join these screened participants to their call or reject them as required.)
- The option to assign a unique reference code for each conference call
- The ability to visually see who's talking
- The option to record your conference call and provide a playback number for participants unable to attend

Not only does the Instant Meeting Web Moderator tool allow you to have a visual display of your "in-conference" participants, but you can also distribute automated reports featuring your participants' data captured during the conference call. You can also e-mail your participant details and subsequently keep attendance records.
